Secretary Marcia L. Fudge is the 18th Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development. She is presently serving in this capacity under the Biden-Harris Administration. She was confirmed by the Senate on March 10, 2021.

Secretary Fudge was born October 29,1952 in Cleveland, Ohio. She received her law degree from Cleveland-Marshall College of Law in 1980.

In 1999, Secretary Fudge was elected the first female and first African American mayor of Warrensville Heights, Ohio. She served two terms.

Her goals as the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development are as follows:


- To eradicate homelessness
